

This was also the first race I have competed in that had required pit stops so that was interesting.

I started off the race well and was running with a gameplan of making a pit stop at either lap 70 or the first full course yellow flag. Everything was going to plan until my rear bumper came loose and flew off around lap 65. I immediately went into the pits, luckily we were able to retrieve the bumper and get it reattached but it was a very long pit stop. I got back on track and was able to set some fast laps but couldn't overcome the deficit. I finished 2nd in my group behind my best friend Ari who finished 4 laps ahead. I was still proud

of the fact that I was able to finish the race and I can't wait to try it again next year. This was absolutely one of the most fun races of the year.

I Qualified in 16th, with only a 0.704 second gap separating the top 20 drivers. The first heat race was awesome and I moved up from 16th to 7th. Unfortunately Heat 2 did not go so great, we selected the wrong gear and I made some poor choices on track, by lap 5 I was back down in 16th and then got into a crash, I was lucky to finish the race in 30th. Heat 3 I had some contact at the start and lost several spots but was able to gain them back and moved up

to 27th. Heat 4 I had awesome pace and jumped up 8 spots finishing 19th on track but a bumper penalty after the race pushed me

back to 27th.
