RFKC - MOSPORT ROUND 1

Round 1 of the Ron Fellows Karting Championship was at one of my favourite tracks and a place we consider a second home, Mosport. Ahead of the event, we had a 2 day team test with Prime Powerteam where we put in a lot of laps and really got our setup dialed in.

During practice we struggled with Engine/Carb issues but my team got that all sorted ahead of the races and on Race Day we were proper fast.

I finished both finals in 4th and at one point was running in 2nd. While it was disappointing to

just miss the podium, we are way ahead of where we thought we would be. Coming into the year my goal was to be on a RFKC podium by the end of the year, I didn't expect to be in the fight for the championship but we are and will push for more in

wait for the next one.

The Ontario Inter-Club Challenge is a new series this year where the 3 biggest karting clubs in Ontario all come together for some huge races. Race 1 was at Goodwood Kartways which is a track I had never raced before and one that quickly became a favourite. The track is super short with a lot of challenging corners and not many spots for passing. There were over 40 racers in my category and we were consistently in the top 5. Unfortunately, after finishing one of the heat races in 2nd, I was disqualified in a post race tech inspection due to my carb having developed an air leak (we are not entirely sure how this happened.) This DQ meant starting the final further back in 11th and on the start another racer was overly aggressive and ended up causing a multi kart crash which ended my race. Despite the frustrating end, I still had a great time and can't
